Circular 11 of 2021: Claims information for beneficiaries treated for COVID-19

The Council for Medical Schemes (CMS) has concluded the process of updating the COVID-19 Data Specification for 2021, as such, 2021 submissions should be submitted on this version.

The revised <u>COVID-19 Data Specification</u> version is with effect from 8 February 2021. The data specification must be read in conjunction with the Healthcare Utilisation Annual Statutory Return Technical <u>Guideline</u> for the preparation of data Version 8.0 and <u>Circular 29 of 2020</u>. The changes are those as listed below:

- 1. New part aimed at collecting COVID-19 vaccine related information.
- 2. New part on financial information (this part was previously submitted in Excel format as per circular 54 of 2020)
- 3. Inclusion of 7 CdRef tables

		2021 should contain data that is already submitted
		previously in 2020, as it is cumulative.

Medical schemes are requested to continue to submit data on a weekly basis through the **CMS' Web portal** and **XML Schema Definitions**, with the exception of financial information per CV5 above which is on a monthly basis.
