In light of the delay since the publication of the Interim Report and the submission of comments in 2021, the Panel wishes to provide an opportunity for stakeholders to make **legal submissions** to the Panel.

The Panel will convene a virtual hearing between 26-28 June 2023 (3 days). Any stakeholder who wishes to make oral legal submissions will be required to submit written legal submissions 7 calendar days before he/she/it is scheduled to present.
